My topic of study is traditional Korean Drum Dancing. The concept of my model is to convey the drum dance of samgomu and the structure and uniformity of the drums themselves with the dynamic motions of the dancers. While all the drums and performers are identical, standing in a straight line with bright colors, masterly-crafted drums, and energetic movements of the dancers create a lively performance. I represent this dominantly through the use of line, shape and form, and color.
